INFORMATION AND PROCEDURES**

The Springdale Rodeo Court, consisting of a Pro West Queen, one Pee Wee Queen and one Pee Wee Princess, represents the Springdale Frontier Days Rodeos and events throughout Washington and parts of Idaho; appearing in parades, rodeos, luncheons and other promotional activities. All applicants for the Pee Wee Royalty must be 16 years of age or younger. Applicants must be willing to abide by the Royalty rules, including responsibility of her horse and transportation, and be available to participate in Royalty activities throughout the year.

**The tryout procedure will be as follows:**

A panel of 2-4 judges will score all portions of the tryouts. The same judges will be used for all contestants.

**Personal Interview – Judging is based on the following:**

Response to the Judges questions  
Conversation ability  
Knowledge or Rodeo and parades  
Positive attitude

**Horsemanship – Judging is based on the following:**

Riding skills (balance, control, good seat)  
Pleasant presentation  
\*\*\*You will be asked to exhibit basic horsemanship skills; which include a set pattern and an arena run. The successful candidate will participate in parades and grand entries at many rodeos and other equine events throughout your reign.

**Dress & Appearance – Judging is base on the following:**

Appropriate western attire including cowboy hat  
Neatness and general appearance

**Knowledge of Horse Care/Tack – Judging is based on the following:**

Cleanliness and condition of horse and tack  
Knowledge of your horse and tack

**RODEO ROYALTY APPEARANCE SCHEDULE – Parades and Rodeos**

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## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND ROYALTY RULES

- 1 Applicant must be at least 16 years of age or younger.
- 2 Applicant may either be an amateur or professional horsewoman.
- 3 Applicant will have her own horse (owned or leased), transportation and trailer. Applicant **MUST** try out on the horse that she plans to use during her reign. Only one horse is required. The horse must be healthy, with current vaccinations and worming. The horse must be kept clean and hooves trimmed. No Stallions, late term pregnant mares or mares with foals allowed.
- 4 Previous Springdale Frontier Days Queens are ineligible.
- 5 The judges will select one Pee Wee Queen and one Pee Wee Princess.
- 6 If a member of Royalty is unable to fulfill her term, the SFD Association members and Royalty Advisors will decide if that position shall be filled for the remainder of the term or will remain vacant.
- 7 The successful candidates will reign from May 18, 2007 until tryouts May 2009.
- 8 All clothing and accessories to be worn by Royalty is your responsibility to provide. Please keep in mind that our colors are Red, White and Black. We will furnish you with a Crown, Serape, Sash, and flowers for parades. Any lost or damaged items that were provided by SFDA are your responsibility to either repair or replace. Please use only Royalty items provided by SFDA for designated court activities. These items are the property of SFDA and it is expected that Royalty members will carefully maintain these items during their reign. Members must be dressed in the appropriate Royalty attire (clean and pressed) at all Royalty events, as designated by the advisor.
- 9 Applicant must be prepared and willing to keep her horse and ALL tack equipment in show condition during events. All parades and appearances require attention to detail in regards to the condition of horse, tack, clothing, serapes and flower pack. Remember! YOU are the spokesperson for our Rodeos and Events! 😊
- 10 All Royalty members and their families are expected to represent the Springdale Frontier Days Rodeo's and events in a courteous, professional manner. A positive attitude and teamwork is expected.

- 11 Any conduct displayed by a member of the SFDA Royalty, or their family, that is detrimental to the title or to the Rodeo will result in automatic disqualification and/or dismissal. Any misconduct, including but not limited to, the list below, will not be tolerated:
  - ▶ Use of illegal drugs, tobacco or alcohol.
  - ▶ Foul Language
  - ▶ Inappropriate behavior, including inappropriate behavior with members of the opposite sex
  - ▶ Attacks or abuse, either physically or verbally, of other Royalty members, family members, rodeo members, or court advisors, including gossip
  - ▶ Abuse or neglect of the member's horse, or any property of the SFDA
  - ▶ Failure to comply with all rules listed.
- 12 The Royalty will be required to attend rodeos, parades, equine events, other events and meetings. (See Tentative Agenda) All appearances are mandatory and all travel is at the expense of the individual Royalty member.
- 13 The Royalty Advisors and the SFDA members will determine the Royalty schedule. When possible, in-county appearances will take precedence over out-of-county functions. Royalty members may suggest possible appearances and functions to attend.
- 14 Parental support and attendance is strongly encouraged. However, parents, friends and guests are in no way to interfere with the Royalty Advisors decision or to disrupt the Royalty at any functions.
- 15 Any problems or concerns that arise, should immediately be brought to the attention of the SFDA Royalty Committee (names and numbers on cover page), or SFDA President.
- 16 While you are part of the SFDA Court you may not compete for any other royalty title without prior written authorization from the SFDA Royalty Advisors.
- 17 After the coronation, the chosen Queen and Princess are expected to remain at the event and demonstrate good behavior and sportsmanship. You will be expected to help in the awards ceremony at the end of the Pee Wee Rodeo.
- 18 Applicant shall waive all liability. A parent or legal guardian must cosign the application.
