**2011 SPRINGDALE FRONTIER DAYS ROYALTY TRYOUTS
INFORMATION AND PROCEDURES**

The Springdale Rodeo Court consists of one ProWest Rodeo Queen, one PeeWee Rodeo Queen and one PeeWee Rodeo Princess. They will represent the Springdale Frontier Rodeo in events throughout Washington and parts of Idaho. They will attend luncheons and appear in parades and promotional activities. All applicants for the Pee Wee royalty must be 15 years old or younger. The Pro West royalty must be 16 years old or older. All applicants must be willing to abide by the Royalty Rules, including responsibility for her horse, including transportation, and be available to participate in Royalty activities and at least half of the SFDA meetings throughout the year.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Must be mailed and postmarked no later than September 15, 2010.

RODEO ROYALTY TRYOUT SCHEDULE:

Tryouts are scheduled for Saturday, September 25, 2010 at the Springdale Frontier Days Arena.

7:00 am	Check in and warm up.
8:00 am	Personal Interviews, Speeches and Knowledge (Starting with PeeWee)
10:00 am (approx)	Horsemanship (arena run) and set pattern A. Starting with PeeWee contestants B. Pattern will be posted that day C. PeeWee pattern may differ from the ProWest pattern)
11:30 am (approx)	Crowning

The tryout procedure will be as follows:

A panel of 3 to 5 judges will score all portions of the tryouts. The same judges will be used for all contestants.

PERSONAL INTERVIEW: This process will include individual interviews with the judging panel. This is an opportunity for the judges to get to know you and see how you react to interviews and the public and media attention.

SPEECHES: There are several opportunities for the Royalty to speak to the public throughout the year. The speech portion of the tryouts will consist of a 3 to 5 minute speech telling something about yourself, what the Springdale Frontier Days Rodeos and events mean to you and your reason for wanting to represent the Springdale Frontier Days Association. After the speech, all applicants will be asked a randomly drawn question and be required to give an answer or response to this question.

HORSEMANSHIP JUDGING: You will be asked to exhibit basic horsemanship skills; which will include an arena run and a set pattern. We want to see how you and your horse work together as a team. The successful candidate will participate in parades and grand entries at many rodeos and other equine events throughout your reign. Your horse and tack need to be clean and in good working order at all times. No tack that drags the ground or can cause a danger to yourself or others will be allowed.

ROYALTY RULES

1. MUST be within the age limitations.
2. MUST provide your own transportation for yourself and your horse.
3. Queens can only reign one year. Previous PeeWee Princesses my tryout for the PeeWee Queen the following year.
4. MUST have your own horse (owned, leased or borrowed). Applicant must try out on the horse that she intends to use during her reign. Shoeing and trimming is at your own expense. If your horse is hurt or injured before, during or after any event you are attending for SFDA, we will not be responsible for any vet or farrier bills.
5. If a member of the Royalty is unable to fulfill her term, the SFDA Royalty Advisors and SFDA members will decide if that position will be filled or remain empty for the remainder of the year. (The SFDA Board may overrule any hostile decisions or any decision if it is deemed necessary at any time.)
6. The successful candidate will reign from October 1st to October 1st of the following year.
7. All clothing and accessories worn by the Royalty are each person's responsibility to provide. Including but not limited to shirts, pants, hats, boots, belts, etc. Please keep in mind that our colors are red, white and black. SFDA will provide you with a crown, serape, sash and flower pack. These items are the property of the SFDA and will be returned in good order at the end of your reign. If you change any of these items, your Royalty Advisor must approve them. Any and all changes will be at your expense and will not be reimbursed by the SFDA, whether or not they are approved. Any loss or damage to the SFDA provided items will require repair or replacement at your expense and will not be reimbursed by SFDA. Please use only the Royalty items provided by the SFDA for designated court activities. These items are the property of the SFDA and it is expected that the Royalty member will carefully maintain them during your reign. Royalty members must be dressed appropriately (clean and pressed) at all Royalty functions.
8. Applicant must be willing and prepared to keep her horse and all tack and equipment in show condition during events. SFDA provides no tack or equipment. This includes but is not limited to breast collars, bridles, saddles, pads, reins, etc. All parades and appearances require attention to detail in regard to the condition of the horse, tack, clothing, serape and flower pack. REMEMBER! YOU are the live advertisement for our rodeos, events and association.
9. ALL ROYALTY MEMBERS AND THEIR FAMILIES are expected to represent the SFDA and events in a courteous and professional manner. A positive attitude and teamwork is expected at all times. No use of illegal drugs, tobacco or alcohol. No foul language. No inappropriate behavior, including inappropriate behavior with members of the opposite sex. No attacks or harassment either physically or verbally of other Royalty members, family members, rodeo members or court advisors will be tolerated. No abuse or neglect of the members' horse or any property of the SFDA. (Any of these acts will result in immediate termination of this Royalty member.)
10. All Royalty members must attend at least 50% of all meetings. The advisor will contact and remind Royalty of meetings, places and times. (Please let the advisor know ahead of

time if possible so that she can add you to the agenda so that you can talk about fun activities and future plans.)

11. Any complaints or problems that you want brought to the attention of the SFDA Board of Directors must be in written form and given to the Royalty Advisor. The Advisor is required to bring this matter to the Board of Directors immediately. All complaints will be kept confidential.
12. Parental support and attendance is strongly encouraged. However, parents, friends, guests or guardians are there as support and are not to interfere with the Royalty Advisor or to disrupt the Royalty at any function. If there is an issue regarding this issue, the final decision will be made by the SFDA Board of Directors.
13. During your reign in the SFDA Royalty Court you may not compete for any other title with another association during the same time. This will result in loss of your position as Queen or Princess and asked to return all property received at the start of your reign including the crown.
14. All travel costs are at the expense of the Royalty member.
15. If at any time the Royalty Advisor is not available to you, you can be assisted by a member of the Royalty committee or a SFDA Board of Directors member.
